GATLINBURG –There is still time to enroll your child in Arrowmont’s Art Workshops for Youth slated for June 6-30. Three different workshops are offered each of the four weeks for different age categories: 7-9; 9-12; and 13 and over. Workshops will be held at Pi Beta Phi Elementary Monday-Thursday from 9:00-11:30 a.m. Tuition is \$65 per week per student and includes the art supplies.

For ages 7-9, the classes include: “Storytelling with Clay” taught by Karen Byars June 6-9; “Puppets and Mask Making” with Beverly Jones June 13-16; “Painting—Check it Out!” with Maria Payer June 20-23; and “Exuberance: A Passion of Drawing” with Morgan Owens June 27-30.

For adventurous and curious 9-12 year-olds, workshop offerings include: “Dream Toy,” instructed by internationally known artist Akira Blount June 6-9; “Paper, Rock, Scissors” by Beth Watson June 13-16; “Puppets and Mask Making” with Beverly Jones June 20-23; and “Imagine the Possibilities and Print It” with Debbie Fullington June 27-30.

Thirteen to 18 year olds will be both stimulated and challenged with classes such as: “Pinhole Photography” with Donna Moore June 6-9; “Raku, Pit and Electric Fired Methods” with Karen Byars June 13-16; “Around the World with Marbling” instructed by Pat Thomas June 20-23; and “Create with Metal” instructed by Elizabeth Hake June 27-30.
