COURSE DESCRIPTION

This class will focus on observational drawing in charcoal. We will work in a variety of genres, including still life, landscape, and interior space. In all cases our emphasis will be on naturalism, and on finding extraordinary beauty in simple subjects. Our goal will be to faithfully and poetically render what we see, with a special focus on depicting subjects in value (light and dark), rather than in outline. We will work additively (direct drawing onto white paper), subtractively (removing or erasing value from a toned surface) and in combination of both. Projects will range from short studies to longer, more finished drawings.

MATERIALS LIST

- > Roll of artist's tape (any type)
- > Strathmore 500 series Charcoal Pad or equivalent good quality drawing pad, White, 18" x 24"
- > Willow *Charcoal, Box 3, soft (Vine charcoal also acceptable)
- > Willow *Charcoal, Box 12, medium (Vine charcoal also acceptable)
- > Cretacolor *compressed charcoal, pack of 3
- > *Large Kneaded Eraser
- > *Artist Chamois
- > Random *pencils and *erasers for preparatory sketches (optional)
- > *Small sketchbook (optional)
- > *Disposable dust or surgical mask to the list (for applying powdered charcoal)
- > *Padlock for your studio locker, if desired (For rent in the Supply Store for the week)
- > *Flash drive (to protect and save data to from Library computers)

All Items marked with an "*" are available for purchase in the Supply Store

MATERIALS FEES: \$45.00-\$95.00
