COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will present hand-built forms incorporating commercial mold cast pieces and sprig mold embellishments. Attendees will have a hands-on demonstration of casting a one part mold for sprig use. Sprigs will then be explored in a variety of embellishing techniques in addition to creating new works from your craft-mold made objects. This workshop is based on assembling and embellishing amazing new work for your portfolio! Throwers are more than welcome in this class. Sprigs can embellish all things!

Note: Participants are to bring at least 3 small objects (no more than 4x4") that quickly releases from a plaster mold you are to make at workshop. No undercuts on your object! Example of a form without an undercut: a jell-o or chocolate mold has no undercuts so the forms they make release easily. ALSO: BRING HOBBY MOLDS TO SLIP CAST FROM!! The class participants will swap out cast pieces from these molds and cut/assemble/combine parts making new pieces!


MATERIALS LIST

- Plastic to cover work
- *Xacto knife
- Bucket
- *Cut off wire
- *Rubber rib, *metal rib (2), *wooden and *serrated rib
- Applicator for *slip trailing with a few tips. Example:

- Variety of *rubber tip pencil-type tools for indenting and drawing on clay. Example:

- Found objects (at least 3) without any undercuts to make a one-part press mold of. Shouldn't be larger than 4x4"
- Cheap *1-2" wide brush to apply parting compound to mold.
- 1 Snap lid plastic container no bigger than 2x6x12" for using as a damp box for press molded sprigs.
- 2 Plastic containers that correlate in size with found objects you bring to pour plaster into and cover your object that you are making a press mold of (should be at least 2 inches higher than the object you are making mold of. You can simply get plastic food containers for this.)
- **BRING SOME PLASTER HOBBY MOLDS YOU MAY ALREADY HAVE OR ORDER SOME ON EBAY, ETC. EXAMPLE: Search on ebay.com Ceramic Mold for simple two part hobby molds (made of plaster) that we will take casts from.**
- *Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
- *Padlock for your studio locker, if desired (For rent in the Supply Store for the week)

All Items marked with an "*" are available for purchase in the Supply Store

Clay must be purchased on campus during class from the Supply Store. No outside clay is allowed in the studios to lessen accidents in kilns. Only requested clay(s) from Instructors will be available for student purchases.

Students should consider bringing packaging materials (bubblewrap, newsprint, etc.) to transport pieces home.

COVID-19 UPDATE
