Lacy Snowflake Ornaments - *Sasha Baskin*

Textiles Studio | Adult; Children 13 and up

Snowflakes come in all shapes, sizes, and patterns. This class uses basic bobbin and needle lace techniques to design and stitch your own snowflake that will last for years to come. Walk away with your own unique snowflake to hang in your window or on your tree this holiday season!

Create your very own handmade wreath to add to your holiday decor! Working with handbuilding techniques in clay, we will make decorative holiday wreaths that are sure to bring cheer to any home. Flowers, leaves, and miniature birds will be demonstrated to give your wreath a personal touch. Work will be fired and available for pick up the following week.

Kari Woolsey is from Boca Raton, Florida. She graduated from Florida Atlantic University with her BFA in ceramics. She attended graduate school at Southern Illinois University. Supplemental to her formal education, craft school and workshop experiences have aided her development as a functional potter, in addition to her working relationship with the Clay Arts Vegas studio located in Nevada, where she was the 2017 Summer Artist in Residence. She is currently an Artist-in-Residence at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts.

Cake Stand! - *Stephanie Wilhelm*

Pottery Studio | Adult; Children 10 and up; Adult with child 7 and up

With hand building and surface techniques in clay, you will make, build, and decorate your own cake stand that will be ready to use just in time for serving your holiday guests that one of a kind family cake recipe.

Stephanie Wilhelm was raised in the small town of Manchester, MD. She attained her BFA at Elizabethtown College. After graduating, she furthered her skills in ceramics by working for a production potter in her home town

and continued her education by earning a Certificate in the Ceramic Arts at Hood College. For 6 years Stephanie found community and education within the wood-firing network around her and completed a year-long apprenticeship with a wood fire potter. Stephanie Wilhelm received a 2017 NCECA Graduate Student Fellowship for research on Bon Fresco and ceramics which she conducted in Italy. She completed her MFA in Ceramics at the University of Florida in the spring of 2018 and currently is a 2018-2019 Artist in Residence at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts.

Turning Studio | Adult; Children 14 and up

Look out kids, the Rolling Pin Express is coming to town! Hop on board to turn your own cookie rolling pin by learning lathe techniques and woodshop skills. Once turned we will move on down to the kitchen where we'll put our pins to good use rolling out cookie dough for some afternoon snacks.

Heather Ashworth is the Wood Studios Technician for Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts in Gatlinburg, TN. Following high school she spent a year at a woodworking trade school in St. Louis, MO before attending and graduating Murray State University with a BFA in Furniture Design. In 2012, Heather was an Artist-in-Residence at Arrowmont, after which she accepted a permanent position.

Watercolor Winter Wonderland - Paige Burchell

Drawing Studio | Adult; Children 9 and up; Adult with child 6 and up

This holiday class will focus on drawing and painting with watercolor "en plain air" winter landscapes. If the weather is too chilly (or even snowy!) we will focus on winter themed still life paintings inside where it's cozy. We will explore the many techniques that can be used with watercolors to make beautiful unique paintings.

Paige Burchell is a graduate of The University of Tennessee where she received a BFA, double majoring in Studio Art and Art Education (2014), and a Master's in Art Education (2015). She has also received an Educational Specialist Degree, in Instructional Leadership, at Lincoln Memorial University (2018). Miniature Marbling & Miniature Books - Pat K. Thomas

Fibers Studio | Adult; Children 12 and up

Let's scale down classic designs for miniature marbling using special small tools and a small tray, 11" x 14". Then in the afternoon, we'll construct miniature books--- 3" x 3"--- or even smaller! Perfect for gift-giving, keeping, or ornaments on your holiday tree that Tiny Tim would approve!

Pat K. Thomas is a full-time studio artist and has been marbling since 1990. She is an artist/partner of the historic 1930's Cliff Dwellers Gallery in Gatlinburg, Tennessee. Thomas teaches classes at Arrowmont, the John C. Campbell Folk School as well as at regional art, history and event centers.

Painting Studio | Adult; Children 10 and up; Adult with child 8 and up

Personalize your Holiday cards this year with your own custom block-printed design. Students will explore drawing, image tracing, and linoleum block carving to create their one-of-a-kind card designs and prints. From holly trees, silver bells, and red-nosed reindeer your holiday cards will be some to remember.
