COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this workshop, students will learn small-scale casting techniques. The casting process allows artists to work more sculpturally, create multiples, and explore the visual aspects of various casting processes. Students will have the opportunity to create work using the lost wax, cuttle-bone, sand casting, and stone casting processes. The history of these casting methods and their application in jewelry, adornment, and as accessories will be covered. In this workshop students will learn how to set up a casting area in their studio as well as materials, tools, safety concerns, and the pros and cons of each process. Open to all levels. Basic skills, such as sawing and soldering, are recommended but not required.

MATERIALS LIST

- Sketchbook
- Pen/Pencil
- 2 – N95 masks
- Optional: 1-3 ounces of silver casting grain. In class we will cast with bronze
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
- Padlock for your studio locker, if desired (For rent in the Supply Store for the week)
